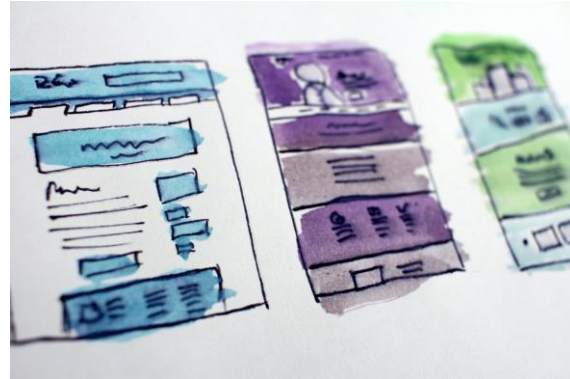

A3.1. Policy Paper



- to analyse the main results and considerations gathered by the 7 countries of the project consortium and provide a map of recommendations based on the results and experiences achieved, both at qualitative and quantitative levels;
- to explain the potential of continuing education and training in educational technologies of adult educators, community educators and social workers in Europe;
- to explain the benefits of developing game-based learning strategies to reach hard-to-reach institutionalised young adults and/or young adults in alternative care.

A3.2. Organisation of Skills4Life Learning Labs by all partners



- to present and showcase the Project Results: SKILLS4LIFE Serious Game, In-Service Training Programme, Handbook on the Development of Transition to Autonomy Programmes, Online Platform;
- to enable the engagement and interaction with the target groups and stakeholders with the developed resources;
- to promote the creation of new community dynamics and synergies, seeking new spaces for coexistence and social inclusion and multicultural coexistence.
